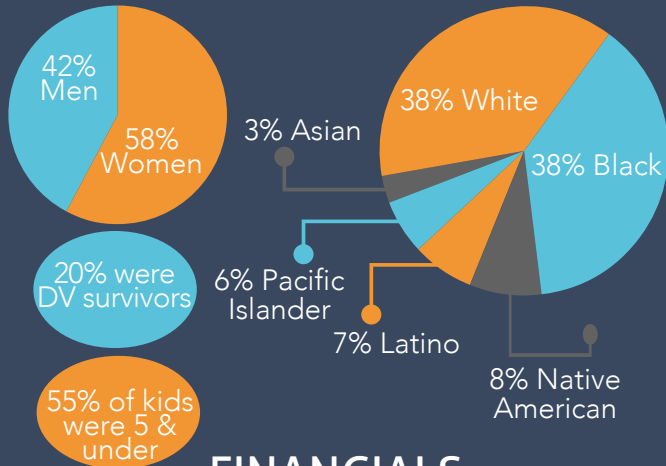

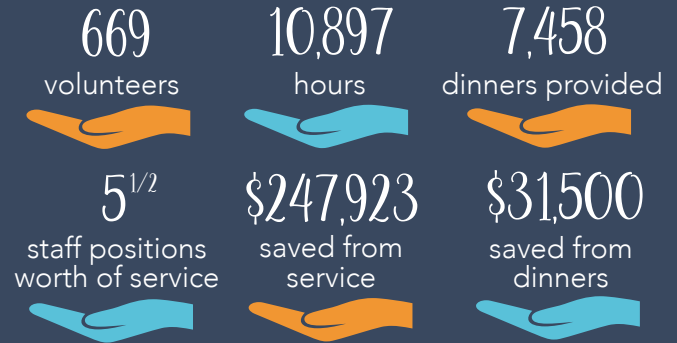

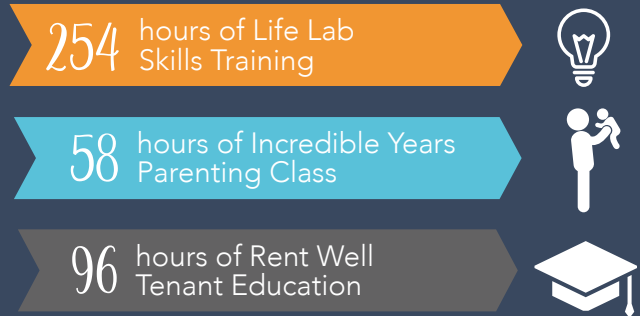

HOUSING FIRST PROGRAM

PHFS helps families experiencing homelessness move back into housing as quickly as possible. We provide rent assistance and case management for 6-12 months to help families keep their housing long-term.



DAY & NIGHT SHELTER

PHFS provides 24 hours of shelter every night of the year for families experiencing homelessness. We rely on a team of over 600 volunteers to help provide supportive, compassionate services.



LIFE LAB SKILLS TRAINING

PHFS teaches evidence-based classes to help families learn new tools and skills they can use to help them get and retain housing. Our classes include: Incredible Years Parenting, Rent Well Tenant Education, and the ARISE Life Skills Curriculum.
